# Inspiring Education in the heart of the University City of Oxford



Summer in Oxford is a fascinating experience. The colleges, galleries and history of one of the world's most famous Universities provide an inspiring and beautiful environment for students from all over the world. Oxford International Study Centre has organised summer programmes for many years, welcoming students of all ages from over thirty countries. Older students are sometimes taught in the University, as well as at OISC, which occupies a listed building in the very centre of Oxford, next to Christ Church, one of the largest Colleges of the University, and home to the Cathedral.

For students with us in summer who are thinking at some stage of applying to UK Universities, including Oxford and Cambridge, the Principal and International Director are happy to offer them individual advice during their course.

### We offer a range of programmes, including:

- English Language and Culture. Students are taught in international groups, unless closed-group teaching has been requested, and are grouped according to age and level of English. The programme consists of:
  - > 20 lessons a week
  - Activities locally each weekday
  - Weekend excursion (full day)

Additional tuition on a one to one basis eg for IELTS exams may be booked.

• English Language, Culture and Academic Enrichment.

The programme consists of:

- 20 lessons a week of English Language
- 10 lessons a week of academic preparation, including for extra tuition for English Language, including tests if required (eg IELTS), ALevel, IB, Abitur, and (I)GCSE Students may choose one or two subjects per week.
- Activities locally each weekday
- Weekend excursion (full day)
- Other programmes offered

These include:

- > Specially designed programmes with a choice of over 30 subjects
- University pre-sessional programmes, including English Language, Study Skills and Academic specialisms;
- Abitur preparation programmes(Englisch als Lk);
- Oxford and Cambridge interview and test preparation (one to one)
- Boarding School entrance tests preparation (one to one)

Summer can be fun as well as academically enriching, and we want our students to enjoy all that Oxford has to offer. Every weekday we arrange cultural, sports and leisure activities. These include punting on the river, visits to galleries and museums, the Colleges of the University with their beautiful architecture dating from medieval times, and (for younger students) Harry Potter tours, treasure hunts, selfie tours of Oxford... the list goes on!



At weekends we arrange full day excursions to destinations such as Stratford and Warwick, London, including a boat ride on the Thames, and Cambridge.

#### **Tuition**

• English Language and Culture. £440 per week

English Language, Culture and Academic Enrichment. £840 per week
This programme includes individual tuition in academic subjects

• Individual tuition 10 lessons £560 per week (and pro rata)

Extra individual tuition £60 per lesson

#### **Accommodation**

Host family: £275 per week (Age 16+); £295 per week (12-15); £315 per week (under 12)

**Student Residence:** from £400 per week

University: from £650 per week

All accommodation options are offered subject to availability. Accommodation is in single rooms (unless friends wish to share), with breakfast and dinner included. University and Residence have private bathrooms.

Students arrive Sundays and leave on Saturdays. Since school holidays differ internationally there are no set dates, and students may stay for any number of weeks.

London Heathrow: £140 each way

London Gatwick: £170 each way

Other airports are more expensive and a quotation can be provided on request.

#### **Student discounts**

We offer a reduction in fees for students joining the programme in **small groups** of two or more;

Most students stay for one, two or three weeks during the summer. Those saying for **three weeks** will receive a 25% discount on tuition fees for the third week.
